### Ingredients

Beef Molasses, Soybean Meal, Monocalcium Phosphate, Monocalcium Phosphate, Vegetable Oil, Magnesium Oxide, Dehydrated Aspergillus Orizae Fermentation Extract, Zinc Oxide, Zinc Proteinate (Reg. No. 990629), Copper Sulfate, Copper Proteinate (Reg. No. 990579), Cobalt Tartrate, Sodium Selenate, Manganese Oxide, Manganese Proteinate (Reg. No. 990603), Ethylenediamine Dihydrochloride, Potassium Iodide, Calcium Carbonate, Vitamin A, Vitamin D3, Vitamin E, Thiamine Mononitrate, Biotin, Folic Acid, D-Pantothenic Acid, Pyridoxine Hydrochloride, Vitamin B12, Riboflavin, Ascorbic Acid, Menthyl, Menthyl Dimerhylsuccinyl Sulfate and Ethoxyglycol.

### Feeding Recommendations

Expected intake is 220-385 grams (8-14 ounces or 1/4-1/2 lb.) per head per day. Product should be available continuously. Locate tubs near a source of water, salt or feeding area. On open range locate tubs where animals congregate, near gaps or along trails. Variables in consumption could be temperature, humidity, type of animal, animal size, stage of production and animal health. The quality, source, availability of roughage and/or light grain may also affect consumption. Measure product upon first introduction to figure consumption. Tub levels approximately 3.2 kg (7 lb.) per inch. Increase consumption by decreasing number of head or adding another tub. To reduce consumption, increase number of head or move tubs away from congregating areas. If the tub, remove a tub. Always provide a fresh, clean source of water and free choice salt.

**Warning:** Contains high levels of copper. Do not feed to sheep.  
**Selenium Caution:** Directions for use must be carefully followed.  
**Do not use in association with other feed containing supplemental selenium.**
